


WELCOME






2 Other highlights

- For the 1st time, we held a Caribbean panel « How the Caribbean Contributes to the Global Film and TV Industry »
















We screened 15 great movies (features, documentaries, shorts) which are currently looking for distribution. For most of them, it was their premiere.
